## Conjunctions (and more!) Bingo

$i$ How to play

Conjunctions bingo gives students practice reading and saying conjunctions. Each student, pair or group is given a bingo card with five sentences on it.

Each sentence is missing a conjunction. The game leader for each group, or the teacher leading the game for the whole group, pulls conjunctions out of a bag one at a time. Cut up sheet $A$ to make the cards for the bag. Replace the cards back into the hat as many of them can be used more than once.

If the conjunction that is called out fits into a gap in a sentence on their card, students write it into the appropriate sentence. The first student to have all five sentences complete calls out 'Bingo'.

At the end of the game the winning team has to read all of their completed sentences.

If there are any mistakes, the team erases it and the game continues.

The game leader should note the conjunctions that have been pulled out, in order to verify the winning teams' answers.

If there are any mistakes, it is erased and the game continues.

## Follow Up

Students may be asked to rewrite their sentences using a different conjunction.

Sheet A:

Cut into cards and put into a bag or box. Pull out one by one. Players try to fit the conjunction into a sentence on their game sheets (Sheet B).

## Sheet B:

These cards are given to each student or pair of students. As the teacher pulls a Sheet A card from the hat, students attempt to fill the blanks with them correctly.
